**INTRODUCTION**

Telangana Social Welfare Residential Sainik School, Rukmapur, is the first state government-run Sainik School in Telangana on similar lines of Central Sainik Schools. This school combines robust academic education in affiliation to the CBSE along with rigorous military Education & Training from grade-VI to XII. It commenced from Academic Session 2018-19.

**MISSION**

The mission of this School is to encourage the Cadets to dream of alternate career other than Engineering & Medicine and prepare them to gain entry into the Army, Navy and Air Force in the Officer Cadre.

**AIMS & OBJECTIVES**

In pursuance of this mission, the Sainik School has been taken up with the following objectives: -

**NEW ADMISSIONS**

Admissions are provided at two entry points in class-VI & XI in TSWR Sainik School, Rukmapur, Karimnagar District every year. As this specialised school is first of its kind in the education sector of the Telangana state, candidates from all over the state are given an opportunity to apply for admissions in this institution. The school is affiliated to CBSE.

Applications are invited online for admission into **Class VI (80 seats)** at Telangana Social Welfare Residential Sainik School, Rukmapur, Karimnagar District for the academic year 2024 -25. **As the school is specially meant for providing military education and training with regular academics, candidates, who are not desirous of joining the Indian armed forces, are advised not to apply.**

### ELIGIBILITY

- The students (only Boys), who appear for class-V examination from any recognised school for the academic year 2023-24, are eligible to write Common Entrance Test-2024 (Stage-I) and Stage-II Screening Tests.
- The annual income of the parent should not exceed Rs.2,00,000/- per annum (for Urban students) and Rs.1,50,000/- (for Rural students) as certified by the MRO.
- The students from Telugu / English medium are eligible for this entrance test.
- The age of the students of all communities (SC, SC-C, ST, BC, Min, OC/EBC) shall not exceed 11 years as on 01.04.2024, i.e they should be born between 01.04.2013 & 31.03.2015.
- The admission for the selected students would be confirmed only after submitting following **certificates in original** along with one set of photocopies at the time of admission.

### APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- The applicant must submit his / her application only through ONLINE by visiting website [www.tswreis.ac.in](http://www.tswreis.ac.in)
- Candidates have to pay registration fee of **Rs.200/-** for submission of application through ONLINE through NET banking / Credit Card / Debit Card / UPI payemnts.
- Before filling the application through online the candidate has to read the information / prospectus already uploaded in the website [www.tswreis.ac.in](http://www.tswreis.ac.in) [**\*ADVICE:** They can prepare a hard copy first and then fill online to avoid mistakes].
- Candidates should upload their passport size photo and signature in \*.jpg or \*.jpeg formats within size of 50 kb (Width-3.5 cm. Height-4.5 cm)
- The Candidates are advised to download their Hall tickets from 06.03.2024 onwards to appear for CET-2024.
- The candidates shall be considered for admission based on their combined merit of Stage-I & II Tests and as per seat matrix of the TSWREI Society.

### SELECTION PROCESS

The selection process broadly consists of following three (3) types of tests.

1. **STAGE-1** - Common Entrance (Written) Examination – **100 Marks**
2. **STAGE-II** - Screening Tests – **150 Marks**  
(Physical, Sainik School Aptitude (Written & Descriptive) & Communication Skill Tests)
3. Medical Fitness Test. – **Fit/Unfit**

## STAGE-I - COMMON ENTRANCE EXAMINATION – 100 MARKS

The written examination will consist of 100 multiple answer questions (Bilingual-English & Telugu) to be answered in 2 hours and 30 minutes. **These questions will be based on Class-V standard textbooks.** To qualify the Sainik School's Common Entrance Test-2024, students need to obtain a minimum of 25% marks in each subject and a minimum of 40% aggregate marks. The distribution of questions is as under:-

Candidates qualifying in the above will be shortlisted and called for Screening Tests (Physical, Sainik School Aptitude & Communication Skills) and Medical Tests in 1:10 ratio in the order of merit as per the merit in the category wise ranking. In case sufficient number of candidate are not found fit in the first round of screening tests, more candidates may be called in the second round of screening tests in the order of merit. Cut off percentage of 40 may be either raised or lowered based on the performance of the candidates in the entrance examination.

## STAGE-II - SCREENING TESTS – 150 MARKS

(Physical, Sainik School Aptitude (Written & Descriptive) & Communication Skill Tests)

### I. PHYSICAL TESTS – 25 MARKS

The following physical tests will be conducted:-

1. Running 4 KM within 20 minutes
2. Push Ups 15
3. Sit Ups 20
4. Chin Ups 3
5. Vertical Rope 3 meter

A candidate is awarded 2 marks for passing in each test and zero marks for failing in a test. A candidate has to score 6 marks to be qualified in physical tests. A candidate scoring less than 6 marks in physical tests is deemed to be 'UNFIT'.

### II. SAINIK SCHOOL APTITUDE TEST – 100 MARKS (WRITTEN & DESCRIPTIVE)

The Sainik Aptitude Test for class-VI will be conducted as a subjective and descriptive paper. The Question Paper of this test will be unique for every batch of candidates to be shortlisted based on merit (category wise) of the state level entrance exam / every day as per the schedule of screening tests. The same will consist of the following: -

1. Logical reasoning and quantitative aptitude - **20 Marks.**
2. English aptitude to include comprehension passage, story writing, letter, conversation poster making - **20 Marks.**
3. Mathematical aptitude to include rules of divisibility, angles, HCF, LCM, factors and multiples, prime & composite numbers, time conversion of units - **20 Marks**
4. EVS aptitude to include Animals, agriculture, body parts, forests, rivers, atmosphere, sun and the planets - **20 Marks**
5. Social Science aptitude to include basic history and culture of India, basics on solar system and earth - **20 Marks.**

**Note:** The above questions will be in English medium only.

### **III. COMMUNICATION SKILLS TEST (ORAL) – 25 MARKS**

All candidates appearing for the Stage-II Screening will be tested for communication skills (oral)

### **IV. MEDICAL FITNESS TESTS**

All candidates before admission to the Sainik School will be subjected to a medical examination by a Board consisting of military / civil doctor and a Health Supervisor of the institution. The standard of health and medical fitness would be based on the standards as laid down for the NDA Examination with minor modification in view of the tender age of the boys. Only those candidates who are found medically fit during these medical tests, will be considered in making final combined merit of all the screening tests-2024 for admissions. **The decision of the Medical Board will be final.**

The minimum acceptable medical standards will be as under :-

#### **A. VISUAL STANDARDS**

- I. **COLOUR BLINDNESS CASES ARE NOT PERMITTED.**
- II. Standard I : Distant Vision (uncorrected) 6/6 (Both eyes)
- III. Standard II : Distant Vision- Better eye 6/18 Worse eye 5/18 Correctable to 6/166/19. The minimum acceptable visual standard for admission to Sainik School will be standard II. Candidates with visual standard II admitted to NDA after successful completion of their training in Sainik School may be found fit for army only.

Ensure that :-

- a) Myopia not to exceed minus 1.5 including astigmatism.
- b) Manifest Hypermyopio not to exceed plus 2.5 including astigmatism.
- c) Fundus @ Media to be Healthy with no changes in myopia.
- d) Visual Fields to be full in each eye.
- e) Binocular vision and steropsis must be good.
- f) Mild Trachoma State III or IV with a regressive ceneal pannus of not more than 1 to 2 mm may be accepted in the opinion of the specialist, exacerbation of deterioration are not likely.

#### **B. OTHER STANDARDS:** It will also be ensured that :-

- I. There is no evidence of weak constitution, imperfect development serious alformation or obesity weight should not exceed the upper limit laid down in standard scale for 11years /16 years.
- II. There is normal development or impairment of function of the bones of joints.
- III. There is no impediment of speech like stammering etc.
- IV. There is no malformation of the head, deformity from fracture or depression of the bones of the skull.

- V. There is no impaired hearing, discharge from or disease of either ear unhealed or perforation of the tympanic membrane or signs of acute or chronic suppurative otitis Media of evidence of redical or modified redical mastoid operation. A soundly healed perforation without any impairment of the mobility of the drum and without any impairment of hearing should not be cause of rejection.
- VI. There is no disease of the bones of cartilages of the nose or nasal polypus disease or of the nasodharynx and accessory sinuses.
- VII. There are no enlarged glands in the neck and other parts of the body and that thyroid gland is normal. Scars on person for the removal of tuberculous glands are not a cause for rejection provided that there has been no active disease with in the preceding 5 years and the chest is clinically and radiologically clear.
- VIII. There is no disease of throat palates, tonsil or of gums disease or injury affecting the normal function of either mandibular joints. Simple hypertrophy of the tonsils, if there is no history of attacks of tonsillitis, is not a cause of rejection.
- IX. There is no sign of functional or organic disease of the heart and blood vessels.
- X. There is no evidence of pulmonary tuberculosis or previous history of this disease or any other chronic disease of the lungs like Asthma etc.
- XI. There is no evidence of any disease of digestive system including any abnormality of the liver and spleen.
- XII. There is no hernia or tendency there to.
- XIII. There is no hydrocele or definite veriocele or other disease of defect of the genital organs. A candidate who has been operated upon for hydrocele will be accepted if there are no abnormalities of the cord and testicle and there is no evidence of filariasis.
- XIV. There is no fistula and/or fissure of the anus or evidence of heamrrhoida.
- XV. There is no disease of the kidney; All cases of Albuminiuria and Glycosure will be rejected.
- XVI. There are no diseases of the skin of allergic nature like aczema, chronic ulticurea etc. are likely to cause disability or marked disfigurement are a cause for rejection.
- XVII. There is no active, latent congenital veneral disease.
- XVIII. There is no history of evidence of mental disease. Candidate suffering from epilepsy incontinence of urine or ensuresis will not be accepted.
- XIX. There is no squint of morped condition of the eye or of the lids, which is liable to a risk, aggravation or recurrence.
- XX. There is no active trachoma or its complications.
- XXI. A candidate with tattoos on the body (except those permitted by certain religions) will be rejected/disqualified.

**Note:-Further the candidates are requested to note that, the following conditions will lead to medical disqualification:**

- a) Knock Knee
- b) Flat Foot
- c) Over weight / under weight
- d) Previous surgeries
- e) Chronic Deseases
- f) Bent Elbow
- g) Tremors
- h) Tattoos

### **C. HEIGHT & WEIGHT**

The minimum acceptable height and weight as per age are furnished below.

Note: Relaxation of 2.0 cm in height and up to 1.5 kg in weight would be given.
